Tuition

The tuition cost covers classes. This number can be a huge range depending on the school you choose. A community college will be some of the least expensive schools while a private school will be some of the most expensive.

Fees

Fees are additional charges that pay for campus events, facilities, and services. These fees can change based on the school you choose.

Other expenses could include Housing and Meal Plans.

FINANCIAL AID

Student Loans – Aid you pay back, given out by the federal government or loan company, everyone gets offered these.
Grants – Aid you don't pay back, given from federal government for students who NEED financial help, based on parents income.
Scholarships – Aid you don't pay back, money given for something you do particularly well, aid you have control of.

Nevada Promise Scholarship
Nevada Resident; earned a high school diploma or GED; meet all program dealines; enroll in a minimum of 12 semester credit hours in a degree program immediately following graduation; only for community colleges
